Expectations for your submission

Based on the situation and your interview(s) with the hearing officer, you have been assigned a series of reflection questions. In order to complete the sanction, it is expected that you will take time to reflect on the topic and provide a clear, well-developed response that demonstrates that you have thought about the issue and considered all aspects. It is an opportunity to demonstrate the insight you have developed regarding the expectations required of every member of this scholarly community. This should not be used as an opportunity to complain about policies or laws. You must answer all of the following questions in order to complete the reflection paper.

3. What did you learn based on your behavior?
4. How did your actions impact each of the following: you, friends, family, police, staff, others present or not present, community?
5. How have you grown or changed as a result of reflecting on your original decisions?

6. How has your decision-making process changed? If it hasn't changed, explain why not.
7. What have you learned about yourself as a result of your behaviors and your interaction with the student conduct process at NC State?
8. If you were in this situation again, what would you do? What would you consider in making your decisions?
9. How will you apply what you have learned from this incident to future decisions?
10. What sanctions did you complete? What sanctions have had a positive impact upon you? What did you learn from those sanctions?
